Aggrieved of rejection of prayer for grant of regular bail in FIR No.3 dated 2.1.2022, under Sections 15, 27-A of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substance Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Sadar Tohana, District Fatehabad, the present petition is filed.

As per the case set up, on 2.1.2022 police party checked a vehicle bearing registration No.HR-59-C-4620 driven by Hari Singh (petitioner). There was recovery of 19 kilograms of *Kachra Doda Post*.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in custody since 16.5.2022. Investigation is complete. Recovery made from the petitioner was of non-commercial quantity.

Learned State counsel opposes the prayer and submits that the petitioner was apprehended from the spot and is involved in five more FIRs.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, considering the nature and quantity of recovered contraband and the fact that though investigation is complete conclusion of trial is likely to take time, bail is granted to the petitioner on furnishing surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial

Magistrate/ Duty Magistrate concerned.

The petition is allowed.

It is clarified that the observations made hereinabove shall not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending application, if any is rendered infructuous.
