Today, learned counsel for the appellants has filed Power of Attorney on behalf of the appellant Nos.2 to 4 and photocopy of Death Certificate of appellant No.1, which are taken on the record.

As agreed, as per statements of learned counsel for the appellants and learned counsel for the Insurance Company (separately recorded), a sum of ₹11,60,000/- (₹ Eleven Lakh Sixty Thousand Only) over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellants in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. As per the statement of learned counsel for the appellants, the enhanced amount be paid to appellant Nos.2 to 5 in equal shares.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit crossed-cheques in the sum of ₹11,60,000/- in the respective names of appellant Nos.2 to 5, in equal shares, before the concerned MACT on or before 21.09.2022, in compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order.
