The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for the grant of anticipatory bail in G.D. No.027 dated 14.04.2022 registered under Sections 354, 323, 506 and 34 IPC in FIR No.0030 dated 14.04.2022 registered under Sections 354, 323 and 34 IPC at Police Station Sadar Raikot, Ludhiana Rural.

On 04.07.2022, this Court had passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner inter-alia contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the case on account of a matrimonial dispute between his daughter and the complainant; the petitioner is not involved in any other criminal case; the petitioner and his family members were asked to meet the complainant side at Ranjit Singh's place so that the matrimonial dispute between the complainant and the petitioner's daughter could be resolved but during the course of such talks the complainant side attacked the petitioner and his family members; for the attack by the complainant and his family members the petitioner has already got lodged a FIR against the complainant side which is pending investigation; in any case the alleged injuries are simple in nature without any premeditation whatsoever; no recovery is required to be made from the petitioner and that the petitioner is also

ready and willing to join and cooperate with the investigation.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Gunkirat Kaur, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

For arguments, adjourned to 13.09.2022.

In the meanwhile subject to the petitioner's joining investigation as and when called by the investigating agency as also abiding by the other conditions provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C, in the event of his arrest in G.D. No.27 dated 14.04.2022 under Sections 354, 323, 506, 34 IPC in FIR No.30, dated 14.04.2022, registered under Sections 354, 323, 34 IPC at Police Station Sadar Raikot, District Ludhiana Rural, he shall be released on ad interim anticipatory bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer."

Learned State counsel submits that under the afore-quoted order passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation; co-operated with the investigating agency and that his custodial interrogation is not required by the State.

After considering the submissions made on behalf of the petitioner in the afore-quoted order and the statement made on behalf of the State, the interim order of this Court dated 04.07.2022, granting ad interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is ordered to be made absolute.
