The present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of the FIR No.59 dated 25.11.2020, under Section 364A, 323 and 341 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar, Mahendergarh based upon compromise Annexure P-2.

On the last date of hearing i.e. on 27.04.2022 a proxy counsel had appeared and had prayed for withdrawal of the present petition but he was not permitted to do so in view of the fact that he was not the counsel in the present case and was only a proxy counsel.
