The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for the grant of anticipatory bail in G.D. No.027 dated 14.04.2022 registered under Sections 354, 323, 506 and 34 IPC in FIR No.0030 dated 14.04.2022 registered under Sections 354, 323 and 34 IPC at Police Station Sadar Raikot, Ludhiana Rural.

On 04.07.2022, this Court had passed the following order:-

“Inter-alia relies on the issuance of notice and grant of ad interim anticipatory bail to a similarly placed co-accused – Veer Singh @ Bir Singh who has approached this Court through CRM-M-27957-222 – Veer Singh @ Bir Singh vs. State of Punjab.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Gunkirat Kaur, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

For arguments, adjourned to 13.09.2022.

To be heard along with CRM-M-27957-2022.

In the meanwhile subject to the petitioner's joining investigation as and when called by the investigating agency as also abiding by the other conditions provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C, in the event of his arrest in G.D. No.27 dated 14.04.2022 under Sections 354, 323, 506,

34 IPC in FIR No.30, dated 14.04.2022, registered under Sections 354, 323, 34 IPC at Police Station Sadar Raikot, District Ludhiana Rural, he shall be released on ad interim anticipatory bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer.”

Learned State counsel submits that under the afore-quoted order passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation; co-operated with the investigating agency and that his custodial interrogation is not required by the State.

Through order of even date passed in CRM-M-27957-2022 – Veer Singh @ Bir Singh vs. State of Punjab, this Court has granted anticipatory bail to similarly placed co-accused Veer Singh @ Bir Singh.

In view of the afore statement made on behalf of the State and because similarly placed co-accused Veer Singh @ Bir Singh has been granted anticipatory bail by this Court, the interim order of this Court dated 04.07.2022, granting ad interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is ordered to be made absolute.
