This is a petition that has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C.
for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.244, dated
16.09.2018, registered under Sections 406, 420, 120-B of IPC at Police
Station City Kharar, District SAS Nagar.

By an order dated 30.05.2019, this Court had granted interim bail to the petitioner and directed him to join investigation.
