The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to official respondents No. 1 to 3 for conducting a fair and impartial inquiry into the representation dated 23.04.2019 and further directing the official respondents to take legal action against the private respondents as per law.

Learned State counsel has pointed out that on basis of the complaint of the petitioner, FIR No. 269 dated 21.08.2019 at Police Station Division No. 5 has been registered against three persons and in the said FIR, report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. has also been submitted before the trial Court and has submitted that in view of the same, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

In view of the fact that in pursuance of the complaint made by the petitioner, the FIR has already been registered and the challan has already been presented, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
