Prayer in the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus to get released the minor children of the petitioner, namely, Gurvansh, aged about 2 years and Manroop Kaur, aged about 3 years, from the illegal custody of respondent No.4, namely, Dinesh Kumar, husband of the petitioner.

Today there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.

Vide order dated 15.02.2022, with the consent of the learned counsel for the private parties, the matter was again relegated to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court to settle the dispute amicably. As per the report 01.04.2022 of the Mediator, the parties have settled the dispute by way of executing a written settlement/agreement.

Learned counsel appearing for respondent No.4 submits that it is a matrimonial dispute and as per his instructions, respondent No.4 and the petitioner are living together.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties and have also gone through the documents on record.

Since the matter has been settled amicably between the parties and respondent No. 4 and the petitioner are living together, the petition is disposed of with a direction that the parties will comply with the terms and conditions of the settlement/agreement dated 01.04.2022 executed in the Mediation Centre of this Court.
