1. Prayer in the instant petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 in CWP-9081-2022.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP-9081-2022, was disposed of by directing the respondents to take note of legal notice dated 02.04.2022 got issued by the petitioner and pass an appropriate order in respect thereto in accordance with law, preferably within one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and if on decision, entitlement of the petitioner was established with reference to the record, then payment be released to the petitioner but in case of delay in disbursement of payment, interest @ 6% per annum would be payable for the period of delay.

3. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of needful having been done in terms of order Annexure P/1 and payment as per entitlement having been released to the petitioner, the

petitioner does not press the instant petition and the same may be disposed of as such.

4. In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
