Present petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No.102 dated 11.08.2005 under Section 406, 420, 120-B, 506 IPC registered at Police Station Goraya, District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the complainant-Tarsem Lal has expired on 12.10.2016, as per the death certificate Annexure P-2. Even the main accused namely Prem Singh has also expired on 16.03.2011 and the son of the complainant Pal Ram has submitted an affidavit dated 29.06.2021 Annexure P-3 that he has compromised the matter.

Learned State counsel submits that qua petitioner, the supplementary challan shall be presented taking into consideration, the aforesaid factum of the affidavit after due verification thereof.

Learned counsel for the petitioner thus submits that the present

petition has been rendered infructuous and may be disposed of as such.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed in the present case.
