Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for seeking direction of respondent Nos.1 to 4 to trace the missing brother of the petitioner, namely, Jagtar Singh and take appropriate action against respondent Nos.5 to 9, who are suspicious persons as he was last seen in their accompany.

Notice of motion in this case was issued on 07.12.2018. Pursuant to which reply by way of affidavit dated 01.03.2019 of Manoj Kumar, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Dinanagar, District Gurdaspur was filed.

Learned State counsel draws the attention of this Court to the report Annexur R-6/T attached with the reply to submit that the allegations levelled by the petitioner against respondent Nos.5 to 9 were found to be false. As such no offence is found to be made out against respondent Nos.5 to 9.

Faced with this, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the present petition has been rendered infructuous. However, he prays for the liberty to be granted to the petitioner to avail alternate remedy which may be available to him.

In view of the above, no further order is required to be passed in the matter. Accordingly, the present petition stands disposed of as having been rendered infructuous with the aforesaid liberty.
