The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.113 dated 16.05.2022 registered under Sections 307, 160, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 25, 27, 54, 59 of Arms Act with Police Station Kotwali Kapurthala, District Kapurthala.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 07.07.2022, petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

A reply dated 08.09.2022 has been filed on behalf of respondent-State by the learned State counsel by way of an affidavit of Maninderpal Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Kapurthala stating that the petitioner has joined the investigation. The same is taken on record.

The learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Paramjit Singh admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in this case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 07.07.2022 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
