Instant petition has been filed under Section 482, Cr.P.C., seeking issuance of direction to official respondents No.2 to 8 to submit a status report with regard to application dated 27.08.2021 (Annexure P-5) submitted by the petitioner to the official respondents regarding allegations of harassment, mal-treatment and demand of dowry against private respondents No.9 to 15.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was married to respondent No.9 on 19.04.2014 and a son was born out of wedlock. He submits that in December, 2017, respondent No.9 left for Dubai and in December 2020, petitioner was thrown out from the matrimonial home. Counsel submits that the petitioner submitted an application to the official

respondents on 28.03.2021 (Annexure P-1). Thereafter an agreement was arrived at that the parties will resolve the dispute and respondent No.9 will be called back to settle the matter. However, private respondents instituted litigation against the petitioner instead. Counsel submits that a fresh application dated 27.08.2021 (Annexure P-5) was submitted by the petitioner, which is pending with the official respondents and no action has been taken thereon. Counsel submits that the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to the official respondents to look into the same.

Notice of motion restricted to respondents No.1 to 8 only, at this stage.

On asking of the Court, Mr. A.S.Gill, Senior Deputy Advocate General accepts notice on their behalf.

Having heard counsel for the parties, but without commenting on the allegations levelled in the petition or in the applications submitted by the petitioner, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur – respondent No.5 to examine the representation (Annexure P-5) and to take suitable action thereon as warranted in accordance with law, expeditiously.
