Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail in case having FIR No.96 dated 09.06.2022 registered under Sections 452, 324, 323, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station Sardulgarh, District Mansa.

The counsel for the petitioner submits that as per the allegations, the petitioner and his companions committed trespass and caused simple injuries to the opposite party. The counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation with the police in the light of the previous order.

The Status report by way of affidavit of Jarnail Singh, Assistant Sub-Inspector-cum-Investigation Officer No.687/Mansa, posted at Police Station Sardulgarh, District Mansa filed on behalf of the State, is taken on record.

The State counsel on instructions from ASI Jarnail Singh informed the Court that the petitioner has joined the investigation and recovery of weapon has been effected and now the petitioner is not required by the police for further investigation.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 11.07.2022 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
