By this petition, the petitioner seeks issuance of a direction to respondent No.3 to allot a flat to him under the Chandigarh Small Flats Scheme, 2006, in lieu of Jhuggi No.1105/1, Block B, Labour Colony No.5, Burail, Chandigarh, as the matter is stated to have already been decided by respondent No.2, vide the order dated 22.11.2021 (Annexure P/6), in favour of the petitioner (as contended).

Learned counsel for the petitioner points to the order passed by the Appellate Authority, i.e. Secretary, Estates, Union Territory, Chandigarh, on 22.11.2021 (copy Annexure P/6), to submit that the matter with regard to allotment of a flat to the petitioner was remanded to the Estate Officer for consideration afresh, in terms of the scheme in question, but till date it has not been decided.

Learned counsel appearing for the respondents, on an advanced copy of the petition received, submits that it would be decided within four weeks.

Consequently, this petition is disposed of with a direction that the order to be passed by the Estate Officer, in terms of the order dated 22.11.2021, be passed within a period of one month, after duly hearing the petitioner and considering all pleas raised by him.

Naturally, a detailed speaking order will be required to be passed.
