Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking quashing of FIR No.32 dated 11.06.2011, registered for offences under Sections 406 and 498-A of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station City Banga, District SBS Nagar (Annexure P-2).

At the outset, counsel for the petitioners submits that marriage of the son of petitioners, which was solemnized with complainant-respondent No.2, has been dissolved and a divorce order has been passed by the Federal Magistrate, Court of Australia (Annexure P-1) on 10.03.2011 . He submits that a compromise dated 05.09.2011 (Annexure P-3) has also been arrived at, which is supported by the affidavit (Annexure P-4) of the father and attorney of complainant-respondent No.2. He seeks and is granted permission to withdraw the petition with liberty to file a fresh one seeking quashing of the FIR on the basis of compromise.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.
