The impugned order shows that the petitioners have been permitted to run their atta chaki at 15 ft. from the house of the complainant.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners would shift their atta chaki to a distance of 15 ft. Thus, there is no requirement of permanent shifting. The order dated 23.05.2022 is contradictory.

The writ petition is disposed of with a clarification that in case, the petitioners shift the atta chaki to a distance of 15 ft. from the house of the complainant, they shall not be required to shift it permanently.
