Learned counsel for the petitioner has handed over a sum of Rs.40,000/- to learned counsel for respondent No.1/complainant, who has handed over the same to the complainant-Virender Kumar who is appearing in person in the Court today.

The complainant has been identified by his counsel and photocopy of aadhar card of the complainant has been handed over in the Court. Learned counsel for the complainant on instructions, submits that he has no objection in case the present petition is allowed and the conviction is set aside.

The above said statement made by counsel for the complainant is taken on record.

Petitioner-Kanti Kumar is also present in the Court today. He also submits that he has compromised the matter.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that given the fact of compromise with the complainant and the statement of the complainant that he would have no objection in case the petition is allowed and the conviction is set aside. He further undertakes that he would be contented and satisfied in case, the sentence is reduced to the sentence already undergone by the petitioner.

Since the matter between the parties have been settled amicably on merits. Dispute is only with regard to the payment of cheque amount which has now been settled, therefore the compromise is accepted.

Given the explicit stand by the petitioner and the complainant, the petition is partly allowed. Sentence is reduced to the sentence already undergone by the petitioner. Bail bonds and surety bonds if any, furnished by the petitioner, stands discharged. Pending applications, if any, stand disposed of.
