Instant petition was filed seeking concession of one week parole to attend the marriage of his real sister which was fixed for 08.07.2022.

On 07.07.2022 the following order was passed by this Court:

“Pursuant to the order dated 06.07.2022 passed by this Court, learned State counsel, on instructions from P/SI Ajay Kumar, P.S. Kalka, District Panchkula, informs us that it stands verified that the marriage of the sister of the petitioner is to be solemnised on 08.07.2022.

That apart a Panchayatnama (undated) at Annexure P-3 has been placed on record wherein also the same factual premise stands certified and it has been recited that the Gram Panchayat, Banwai, District Etawah shall take full responsibility that the petitioner would surrender back in jail and there is no threat to the law and order situation if concession of parole is granted.

List on 21.07.2022.

In the meanwhile, directions are issued to the Superintendent, Central Jail, Ambala/competent authorities to release the petitioner forthwith on parole for a period of one week. Petitioner would report back to the jail authorities at Central Jail, Ambala on 15.07.2022 by 5.00 p.m.

A copy of this order be given to counsel for the parties under the signatures of the Bench Secretary.”

Since the concession of parole as sought for was granted to the petitioner in the light of interim directions dated 07.07.2022, nothing survives for adjudication.

Petition is disposed of.
