The petitioners pray for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.49 dated 03.04.2021, registered under Sections 324, 323, 452, 148, 149 and 506 of the IPC at Police Station Haryana, District Hoshiarpur.

Learned counsel for the petitioners, at the very outset, submits that the matter has already been compromised between the parties and a petition, bearing CRM-M-25980-2021, has already been filed before this Court seeking quashing of the FIR on the basis of the compromise.

Mr. Joginder Pal Ratra, DAG, Punjab and Mr. Sandeep Godara, Advocate, who are present in Court, accept notice on behalf of the respondent-State and respondent No. 2/complainant, respectively.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Ajit Singh, assisted by learned counsel for the complainant acknowledges that there is a compromise between the parties.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and the petitioners are granted the concession of anticipatory bail, subject to the

conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

However, it will be open for the Investigating Officer to call upon the petitioners to join investigation, if so required, by issuing them a written notice in this regard.
