The petitioners allegedly took a piece of land on lease from the Gram Panchayat. The said land contains a pit for disposal of sewerage water. Allegedly, possession was not handed over after grant of lease and respondent No.3 has meanwhile dumped cow dung into pit meant for sewerage water leading to its blockage. The term of lease has since expired but despite representation made to respondent No.1 to get the pit cleared and cleaned, no action has been taken.

If, the petitioners are really serious, they can approach the Deputy Commissioner against the inaction of the Block Development and Panchayat Officer. Filing of this writ petition, is not the appropriate remedy.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw this writ petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
