Learned counsel for the petitioners argues that while granting the revised pay scales w.e.f. 01.01.2006, the petitioners were not granted the basic pay as per their entitlement and, therefore, the petitioners are suffering the said prejudice even after their retirement as they are getting pension much less than their entitlement.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have already raised the said grievance before the respondents by way of serving a legal notice dated 23.05.2021 (Annexure P/8), which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioners will be satisfied in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondent No.3 to decide the said legal notice.

Mr. Raman Kumnar Sharma, Addl. A.G. Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and raises no

objection in deciding the legal notice dated 23.05.2021 (Annexure P/8), in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

In view of the request made, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioners in their legal notice, respondent No.3 is directed to decide the legal notice dated 23.05.2021 (Annexure P/8) by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
