Instant petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of regular bail pending trial in FIR No. 87 dated 24.04.2020, under Section 20(B), 61 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Bhondsi, District Gurugram.

Counsel for the parties have been heard.

As per prosecution version an alleged recovery of a total of 33 Kgs of *Ganja* was effected from the present petitioner and who was carrying the same in two separate plastic bags.

The alleged recovery from the petitioner would fall under commercial quantity and as such the rigors of Section 37 of the NDPS Act would apply in this case.

In view of the above, this Court is not inclined to accept the prayer made in the instant application.
