On 06.07.2022, the following order was passed:-

“The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.PC for the grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in a case registered vide FIR No.144 dated 30.06.2018 under Sections 21, 27-A, 61, 85 of NDPS Act 1985 registered at Police Station Kalanwali, District Sirsa.

The Counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner inadvertently did not appear on 19.04.2022 before the trial Court. He is ready and willing to join the proceedings once again. Notice of motion for 07.09.2022.

In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to surrender himself before the trial court within a period of one week from today and on his doing so he shall be

admitted to interim bail to the satisfaction of learned trial Court.”

The learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Rajinder Prasad, submits that pursuant to the said order, the petitioner has surrendered before the Court of learned Sessions Judge, Sirsa on 11.07.2022 and has been admitted to interim bail.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court.
