1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating action against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 10.10.2001 and final order Annexure P/2 dated 24.02.2020, in CWP-16053-2001.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to notice of motion in the instant petition, the respondents have released the benefits admissible to the petitioner in terms of Annexures P/1 and P/2, therefore, in the circumstances, the petitioner does not wish to press the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

3. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
