Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the petitioner had applied for the grant of stage carriage permit with the respondents on 14.01.2022 (Annexure P-3) by submitting an application and depositing requisite documents amounting to fees of Rs.10,000/- but no action has been taken by the respondents on the said application. Thereafter, petitioner served a legal notice upon the respondents on 08.02.2022 (Annexure P-5) which is still pending consideration with the respondents, hence, appropriate direction be given to the respondents to decide the said legal notice of the petitioner dated 08.02.2022 (Annexure P-5).

Mr. Navdeep Chhabra, learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Learned counsel for the respondents raises no objection in deciding the legal notice of the petitioner in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by her in the legal notice dated 08.02.2022 (Annexure P-5), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the legal notice dated 08.02.2022 (Annexure P-5) within a period of three months from the receipt of copy of this order.
