[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating action against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order (Annexure P-2) dated 02.11.2020 in CWP No.18204 of 2020.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-2) reveals that CWP No.18204 of 2020 was disposed of vide order dated 02.11.2020, while directing respondent No.1 to take a final decision in the matter in view of the averments contained in Revised Justice Demand Notice within one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and in case the petitioner was found entitled to the relief claimed, financial benefit accruing therefrom be paid to the petitioner within one month from the date of order by the competent authority.

[3] Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents has filed reply along with copy of speaking order (Annexure R-1) dated

29.09.2021. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof is stated to have been furnished to learned counsel for the petitioner.

[4] However, none is present on behalf of the petitioner nor has any request for adjournment or Passover been made.

[5] A perusal of speaking order (Annexure R-1) dated 29.09.2021 reveals that the claim of the petitioner as contained in the Revised Justice Demand Notice has been rejected.

[6] In view of the position noted above, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner to challenge order (Annexure R-1) dated 29.09.2021 by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.
