Through the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 133 dated 02.06.2022, registered under Sections 406, 420, 120-B IPC, at Police Station Phillaur, District Jalandhar Rural.

At this stage, Mr. Naresh Paul Chandel, Advocate, appears and files memorandum of appearance on behalf of the petitioner in the Court, which is taken on record.

Vide order dated 06.07.2022, *ad interim* anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the aforesaid order dated 06.07.2022, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Surinder Pal, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 06.07.2022 granting *ad interim* anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions envisaged in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
