The petitioners herein are claiming the benefit of being permitted to rejoin the duty as Home Guard volunteer since similarly situated persons had been permitted to do so by the Court in CWP No.23475 of 2015 and other connected matters, vide judgment dated 23.02.2017.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners very fairly contends that the order passed in CWP No.23475 of 2015 and other connected matters, came to be challenged before the Division Bench by virtue of LPA No.1088 of 2018 and other connected LPAs, which order has been set aside. It is submitted that by virtue of the judgment as rendered in LPA No.1088 of 2018, the relief as claimed by the petitioners would not survive.

Accordingly, the instant writ petition stands dismissed.
