The petitioners being successors-in-interest of Chadgi Ram, Lakhi Ram and Bir Singh sons of Budh Ram filed a petition under the Haryana Dohlidar, Butimar, Bhondedar and Muqararidar (Vesting of Proprietary Rights) Act, 2010 for conferment of proprietary rights upon them in respect of 1/3rd share in land measuring 24 kanals and 18 marlas as the said land was dohli land. The petition was allowed vide order dated 11.04.2016 and the said order has become final.

The present writ petition has been filed for suitable modification of order dated 11.04.2016 as proprietary rights have been granted only in respect of the share of the petitioners in the 1/3rd share of dohli land and proprietary rights have not been granted in favour of their brothers and sisters viz. respondents No.5 to 28. Further, it has been prayed that order dated 11.04.2016 be complied with in letter and spirit.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he does not press the first prayer and that a direction may be given to the official respondents to implement order dated 11.04.2016.

A perusal of the record shows that no demand notice has been issued for implementation of the aforementioned order. Thus, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to consider the writ petition as notice of demand and to take action thereupon, in accordance with law. Needful be done within eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
