JAISHREE THAKUR, J.

1. The present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for directing respondent No.2—Secretary, Haryana Staff Selection Commission, Panchkula, to clarify the result of the petitioner herein and in case he has been declared successful, to call him for Physical Screening Test.

2. In brief, the facts are that the petitioner herein applied for the post of Male Constable (G.D.) against advertisement No. 04/2020, CAT No. 01. He was issued Roll No. reflected as 4201252704. The said examination was scheduled to be held on 7.8.2021 and 8.8.2021 in two shifts. It was held on 7.8.2021 but was cancelled thereafter by a public notice issued. Consequent thereto, another admit card was issued for written examination to be held on 2.11.2021. A fresh Roll No. was issued to the petitioner i.e. Roll No. 4201823266. The petitioner undertook the said examination as well and the result was declared on 11.12.2021. Based on the written

examination result, the successful candidates were called for physical screening test. The final result stand declared on 16.6.2022. The case as set up by the petitioner by way of these pleadings is that when the result of the written examination was declared, subsequent roll number of the petitioner was not reflected, therefore, he concluded that he had not passed the written examination, though Roll No. 4201252704 is shown to have passed in the written examination.

3. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner would contend that the petitioner is a young person and confused about the result declared. He had initially appeared under Roll No. 4201252704 but on cancellation appeared under the second roll no. issued. The Roll No. 4201252704 finds mention in the final result declared subsequent to the written examination but the subsequent roll no. does not find mention in the final result published.

4. The prayer of the petitioner herein is that a direction be issued to the Haryana Staff Selection Commission, Panchkula, to inform him as to whether he is successful candidate in written examination held on 2.11.2021 with Roll No. 4201252704.

5. I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and find that this petition is totally frivolous and misconceived. It is an admitted fact that after cancellation of the examination, which was held on 7.8.2021, fresh roll numbers had been issued to all eligible candidates to undertake their examination on 2.11.2021. Therefore, the request of the petitioner to seek clarification whether he is the same person who has been declared successful with the roll number which had been probably allocated to some

other person in the subsequent written examination is frivolous and misconceived. The prayer of the petitioner is unacceptable. The petitioner ought to have secured complete information with regard to his result before filing the instant petition. This Court cannot be used as a forum to collect information.

6. Consequently, the instant writ petition is dismissed. However, in case the petitioner needs any clarification or information, he is always at liberty to approach concerned authority under the Right to Information Act.
