Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail in cross case bearing DDR No.45 dated 11.01.2021, registered under Sections 336, 323, 324, 148 and 149 IPC and Sections 25 and 27 Arms Act, at Police Station Sujampur, District Pathankot in case FIR No.05 dated 09.01.2021 registered under Sections 307, 324, 325, 323, 336, 427, 148, 149 and 120-B IPC and Sections 25/27 Arms Act at Police Station Sujampur, District Pathnakot. The petitioners apprehend their arrest at the hands of Police, in the above FIR.

Learned counsel for petitioner No.3 states that the petition survives only in respect of petitioner No.3, as qua the rest of the petitioners, the petition was dismissed vide order dated 09.08.2021 and pursuant to the said order, the petitioner, who is an accused in cross version recorded through DDR No.45 dated 11.01.2021 in case FIR No.05 dated 09.01.2021, has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, who is assisted by SI Harmesh Kumar

does not dispute this fact that petitioner No.3 has joined the investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation for the time being.

Considering above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 09.08.2021 is made absolute.
