Instant petition had filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for seeking quashing of FIR No.119 dated 26.06.2017 under Sections 419, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (Section 406 Indian Penal Code, 1860 added later on) registered at Police Station City South Moga.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the instant petition had been filed for seeking quashing of FIR on merits, however, during the pendency of the case, the parties have amicably resolved their difference. He thus prays for withdrawal of the instant petition with liberty to move appropriate petition on the strength of the compromise so effected between the parties.

Dismissed as withdraw with liberty as aforesaid.
