A person has come present claiming himself to be Jaswant Rai s/o respondent No.1 and Shiv Charan Dass. He has produced copy of driving licence. A copy thereof is being taken on record as mark 'X'. He submits that the parties have compromised and the petitioner now owes nothing to him.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to order dated 13.09.2022 passed by this Court, as per his instructions, the respondent appeared before SHO concerned and suffered statement to that effect.
