Instant Revision petition has been filed under Section 401, Cr.P.C., challenging order dated 19.04.2022 passed by learned JMIC, Ludhiana in COMA No.5864 of 2020 titled as `Nidhi Bhakoo Versus Sameer Bhakoo and others, whereby petitioner was directed to pay interim maintenance as per order dated 02.03.2022, Annexure P-3. Further challenge is to order dated 06.05.2022, Annexure P-5, passed by learned JMIC, Ludhiana, whereby petitioner has been directed to clear arrears of interim maintenance in three equated instalments.

Heard counsel for the petitioner.

By order dated 02.03.2022, Annexure P-3, Trial Court has ordered petitioner to pay interim monthly maintenance of Rs.10,000/- to respondent-wife and Rs.9000/- (Rs. 4500/- to each of the two children) from the date of application in proceedings instituted by the respondent under Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005. Petitioner has failed to make the payment in compliance of order, Annexure P-3, but has approached the Court impugning subsequent orders dated 19.04.2022 and 06.05.2022, whereby he has been given opportunities to make the payment. It seems that no payment has been made, nor any offer to make the payment has been made before this Court. In this backdrop, this Court is not inclined to entertain the instant petition, which is hereby dismissed.
