The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 186 dated 24.08.2019 under Section 302 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station Samrala, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, after arguing for some time, seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the present petition at this stage but however, submits that the petitioner is in custody since 24.08.2019 and out of 12 witnesses, only 3 witnesses have been examined and thus, prayed that the trial Court be directed to expedite the proceedings.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, present petition is dismissed as withdrawn at this stage.

Since the petitioner is in custody since 24.08.2019, the trial Court is directed to decide the case as expeditiously as possible.

State is also directed to produce the witnesses which are stated to be police officials before the trial Court as expeditiously as possible.
