In the instant petition, the petitioner is seeking a direction under Section 482 Cr.P.C., to take appropriate legal action against respondents No.5 to 7 qua the occurrence dated 01.05.2019.

Reply by way of an affidavit of Jasbinder Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Baghapurana, District Moga has been filed on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4, which is taken on record, wherein in para 2 of the preliminary submission, it has been stated as follows:-

“2. That there is no apprehension to the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family member. Infact, as detailed above petitioner himself tried to take forcible possession of property due to which criminal case has already been registered against him. Moreover, compromise has been effected between the petitioner and Arshdeep Singh, Sukhpreet and Karanpreet Kaur and as per compromise petitioner does not want to initiate any

type of proceedings against Arshdeep Singh etc and he also does not want to proceed with his instant petition. Compromise deed dated 19.06.2019 is attached herewith as Annexure-1/T.

This very fact has not been disputed by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the compromise has been entered into between the parties and they do not want to pursue the present petition further.

As the grievance raised by the petitioner already stands redressed, the present petition has been rendered infructuous, and is disposed off, as such.
