GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioners have approached this Court seeking quashing of FIR No.0101 dated 14.07.2020, Police Station Sultanwind, District Police Commissionerate Amritsar, under Sections 341, 323, 188, 269, 270, 148, 149 of Indian Penal Code and Sections 25, 29, 54 and 59 of Arms Act and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise effected between the parties.
2. Vide order dated 10.08.2021, the parties had been directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/Trial Court so as to get their statements recorded qua the factum of compromise.
3. Report of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Amritsar has been received, wherein it has been reported that statements of petitioners/accused Kiranpal

Singh @ Karan Singh, Harpal Singh, Yadwinder Singh, Sandeep Singh, Buta Singh, Manpreet Singh, Tarsem Singh and also of respondents No.2 and 3-Salwinder Singh and Gurpreet Singh have been recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter amongst themselves.

4. Respondents No.2 and 3-Salwinder Singh and Gurpreet Singh in their statements have stated that they have no objection in case the FIR in question is quashed.
5. Learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Amritsar has specifically opined that the parties have entered into compromise voluntarily without there being any pressure, coercion or undue influence.
6. In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.0101 dated 14.07.2020, Police Station Sultanwind, District Police Commissionerate Amritsar, under Sections 341, 323, 188, 269, 270, 148, 149 of Indian Penal Code and Sections 25, 29, 54 and 59 of Arms Act and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed qua petitioners.
