Present petition has been filed by the petitioner for setting aside the proclamation proceedings initiated against the petitioner including order dated 19.2.2021 (Annexure P-1) and order dated 26.11.2021 (Annexure P-2) whereby the proclamation of the petitioner was issued under Section 82 of Cr.P.C. and order dated 31.5.2022 (Annexure P-3) whereby the petitioner was declared as proclaimed person.

Today, Mr. Umesh Kumar Kanwar, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of the complainant and has resisted the present petition.

Admittedly, the petitioner has joined the proceedings with the trial Court on the basis of the order of interim bail passed by this Court on the last date of hearing. Present case is relating to criminal complaint filed by the complainant-respondent against the petitioner and some other persons under Section 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act which is a bailable offence.

In view of above, as the petitioner has already joined the proceedings before the trial Court and is released on bail, order whereby the petitioner was declared as proclaimed person has become redundant and accordingly, the present petition stands disposed of.
