This is a petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ, direction or order especially in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to consider the candidature of the petitioner i.e. to accept the application form of the petitioner and to grant chance to the petitioner for appearing in the 'combined graduate level examination 2020'.

Learned counsel for the respondents-UOI has pointed out that the selection process involved several stages. The petitioner appeared only in first stage of examination i.e. Tier-1. Thereafter, the petitioner had not even approached the respondents for appearing in the other stages of examination i.e. Tier-2 and Tier-3. As of now, the process of selection stands already completed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has also not disputed the fact that he has never made any written representation to the respondents for participating in the Tier-2 and Tier-3 examination.

In view of the above, the respondents cannot be directed to hold separate examination for the petitioner only, therefore, the present petition cannot be continued any more.

Dismissed.
