This case has been taken up through Video Conferencing via Webex facility in the light of Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 CrPC for directions to respondent-authorities for registration of FIR in connection with murder of petitioner's son namely Sandeep Singh and to get the same investigated through the Crime Branch.

Reply in the matter stands filed by the State of Punjab, as per which it is contended that extensive effort for search of Sandeep Singh had been undertaken and a DDR was also recorded after recovery of body of Sandeep Singh. Further, the joint inquiry into the complaints made by the petitioner was conducted. The petitioner was also associated during the course of inquiry. Spot inspection was also conducted and Secret sources were also deputed. All the allegations are stated to have been looked into and it is submitted that as per inquiry, the son of the petitioner was found to have committed suicide and there is

no evidence with regard to commission of a cognizance offence in the nature of murder of Sandeep Singh. The petitioner has also not named any person and even the Senior Superintendent of Police, concerned has agreed with the said report.

In view of the facts as afore-noticed, the instant petition is dismissed at this stage with liberty to the petitioner to avail of her alternative remedies in accordance with law.
