Through the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. directions are sought to be issued to the State to take appropriate action against the accused persons in FIR No.66 dated 08.04.2016 registered under Section 376 IPC and Sections 3 and 4 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 at Police Station Shimlapuri, District Ludhiana.

At the outset, learned State counsel submits that in the aforesaid FIR except Titu, who has been declared a proclaimed offender, all accused were arrested and thereafter investigation was fairly conducted resulting in the filing of a report by the State under Section 173 Cr.P.C. on the consideration of which the Trial Court framed charges against the accused persons. It is further submitted that out of 15 witnesses cited by the prosecution 05 have been examined and the trial is being diligently pursued by the State.

In the light of the above submissions made on behalf of the State no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition except to the extent that the Trial Court is directed to dispose of the trial expeditiously but not later than six months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
