Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of Code of Criminal Procedure for seeking direction for modification of order dated 07.04.2017 passed by Judicial Magistrate First Class, Karnal in complaint case No.25/2016 titled as 'Rama Sharma Vs. Neel Kamal etc', whereby the petitioner had been summoned to face trial.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2 has informed that during the interregnum, the proceedings in the case have already been finalized and the criminal case No.192/2015 titled as 'State Vs.
