The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for the grant of regular bail in FIR No.61 dated 22.05.2022 registered under Sections 376, 498-A, 506, 120-B IPC at Police Station Sujampur, District Pathankot.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the State had formed a Special Investigation Team (SIT) headed by a Senior Gazetted Officer to enquire into the allegations made against the petitioner in the FIR in question; after inquiry, the SIT has submitted a report exonerating the petitioner of all accusations made against her; the report of the SIT has not only been accepted by the Senior Superintendent of Police, Pathankot but also approved by the concerned District Attorney (Legal) and that on the basis of the afore developments, the State has declared the petitioner to be innocent of all accusations made against her.

Learned State counsel acknowledges and admits to the above

developments.

In the light of the above, this Court is of the opinion that the present case is considered to be a fit one in which the petitioner be directed to be released on regular bail. Resultantly, subject to the satisfaction of the CJM/Duty Magistrate, Pathankot, the petitioner is directed to be released on bail.
