Prayer in this application is for transfer of Civil Suit No. 889 of 2022, pending before Civil Judge (Jr. Division), Jalandhar to a competent Court of law at Kurukshetra.

Learned counsel for the applicants submits that applicant No. 1 was married to the son of respondent, namely Saurabh and applicant No. 1 has given a complaint on 19.03.2022 for registration of the FIR under Sections 498-A and 406 of the IPC, which after verification by the Women Cell resulted into registration of FIR No. 32 dated 23.05.2022 at Police Station Women Police Station Kurukshetra. Thereafter, applicant No. 1 has filed a complaint under Section 12 of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005 and both the cases are pending before the competent Court of law at Kurukshetra.

It is further submitted that now the mother-in-law of applicant No. 1 has filed a frivolous suit for mandatory injunction against applicant No. 1 and her family members that they are threatening, blackmailing and trying to enter into the house of the respondent, though it is the matrimonial

home of applicant No. 1.

Learned counsel further submits that aforesaid suit, filed by the respondent, on the face of it is a counter-blast to the matrimonial proceedings filed by the applicant No. 1 and it will be very difficult for her and her other family members to travel to and from Jalandhar to attend the proceedings, as the Jalandhar is at a very distant place from Kurukshetra.

After hearing learned counsel for the applicants and perusing the record, the present application is allowed.

The Civil Suit No. 889 of 2022, pending before Civil Judge (Jr. Division), Jalandhar is directed to be transferred to a competent Court of law at Kurukshetra.

Liberty is granted to respondent to revive this application in case she wants to contest the same, however, this will be subject to a condition that respondent will pay an amount of Rs. 25,000/- to applicant No. 1 towards the litigation expenses for defending her case at Jalandhar.
