Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in FIR No.54 dated 10.4.2021 registered under Sections 498-A, 406, 354-C, 295, 506 IPC and Section 66(A) of IT, Act at Police Station Raja Sansi, District Amritsar.

By virtue of the order dated 10.8.2021, while granting interim protection, the petitioners were directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioners that the petitioners have joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned State counsel has endorsed the same and submitted that petitioners are no more required for further investigation.
