[1] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner contends that rectification as was done during the pendency of CWP No.4709 of 2017, was not correctly done leading to the writ petition being disposed of by directing payment of only interest.

[2] Learned counsel states that in the circumstances, he requests for permission to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to take out appropriate proceedings in accordance with law qua the rectification which was wrongly done during the pendency of CWP No.4709 of 2017.

[3] In view of the position noted above as well as the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty as prayed for.
