ANOOP CHITKARA J. (ORAL)

Learned State counsel has opposed the present petition on the ground that an FIR under Section 306 IPC cannot be quashed on the basis of compromise. This Court is also of the similar opinion.

Faced with this, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he be permitted to withdraw the present petition. He further submits that he would be satisfied if this Court keeping in view the compromise, directs the trial Court to expedite the trial.
