Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution, *inter alia*, for directing the respondents to consider the claim of petitioner for appointment on compassionate ground on account of the death of her mother on 23.09.2020.

At the outset, learned Counsel on instructions from the petitioner submits that instead of pressing the present petition on merits, her client would be satisfied in case the Legal Notice dated 28.01.2022 (P-7) is decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to the aforesaid limited extent.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Akshita Chauhan, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent(s) and raises no objection against the innocuous prayer of the petitioner.

In view of the above, but without expressing any opinion on merits of the claim of the petitioner, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to the competent authority to consider and decide the aforesaid Legal Notice dated 28.01.2022 (P-7) by passing reasoned order as per law within eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Needless to say that in case there is a failure on the part of competent authority, petitioner would be at liberty to move an appropriate application for revival of this writ petition and the same shall be considered as per law.
