The petitioner seeks the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.162 dated 16.06.2021 under Sections 420, 506, 120-B IPC at Police Station Chhappar, District Yamuna Nagar (Haryana).

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 08.07.2022, passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation. He has also placed on record a receipt showing deposit of Rs.80,000/- in terms of the order dated 06.09.2022 passed by this Court. The same is taken on record as Mark 'A'.

The learned State counsel on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of the order dated 08.07.2022 and has also complied with the order dated 06.09.2022 passed by this Court, and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 08.07.2022 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and she shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of.
